Safe & Smart

The Lawrenceburg Housing Authority supports a unique tutoring and mentoring program for children ages 4-18 who are residents of public housing.

Safe & Smart houses a computer lab, library, two classrooms, and a kitchen. Prior to the past school year, 110 children were furnished with backpacks and school supplies.

The program employs a certified teacher and other volunteer tutors on a daily basis to provide after-school help with class work and nutritious snacks.

Safe & Smart also provides clothes and shoes when necessary, counseling to students and parents, and serves as a liaison between the kids and teachers at school.

During the summer, daily lunch is provided and programs in arts and crafts, field trips, swimming, and neighborhood clean-up programs are conducted.

Safe & Smart relies upon contributions from schools, civic clubs, churches, and individuals to help keep it afloat.

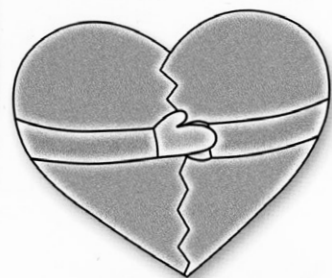
Kid's Place A Child Advocacy Center

Kid's Place, located in Lawrenceburg, provides comprehensive services to child sexual abuse victims and their families.

Kid's Place is a safe, child-friendly environment that provides a non-threatening atmosphere for the comfort and safety of abused children.

Each year, unfortunately, there are more than 200 children in our four-county legislative district that have to be referred to Kid's Place for counseling.

The staff at Kid's Place conducts investigative interviews, provides therapeutic services for child victims, aids in preparation and support through the legal process, and sponsors prevention and community awareness programs.

Backpack Program

For several years, Betsy Cheatwood, a school social worker with the Lawrence County Board of Education, has maintained a backpack program at Ingram Sowell School.

This program provides non-perishable foods to students for the weekend. Any student is eligible to receive one.

At the present time, over 100 children take a backpack home every Friday afternoon. The main source of food is Second Harvest Food Bank.

Any items that are needed to complete a backpack are bought through funds that the community provides. This program has been such a success that other schools in the county have begun to provide meals for the weekend to other school children.

Several groups of individuals come on a weekly basis to prepare these backpacks. Retired teachers, youth centered civic groups, and others are always willing to lend a hand in order to pack these food items and have them ready for disbursement on Friday.

A sign advertising your business and expressing your support or recognizing your individual support of the tournament's beneficiaries. There may be multiple bronze sponsors at the holes that don't have gold or silver sponsors.
